



Young Actors Opportunity

The Forst Inn Arts Collective, a performance venue in Tisch Mills, WI, is looking for several young performers to fill roles in our October, 2021, production of *Fun Home*.

Fun Home is a musical adapted by Lisa Kron and Jeanine Tesori from Alison Bechdel's 2006 graphic memoir of the same name. The scenes and material in which the youth perform are related to mainstream challenges of growing up in a modern family. Other portions of the play cover more challenging themes; however, these are not addressed by the younger characters.

The musical was nominated for twelve Tony Awards, winning five, including Best Musical, and its cast album received a nomination for the 2016 Grammy Award for Best Musical Theater Album.

The show has three roles for young actors. (Ages are flexible)

Christian: Alison's brother, around 8-12 years old (Male, Range: C#4-D5)

John: Alison's brother, around 6-8 years old (Male, Range: C#4-E5)

Alison 1: around 9-13 years old (Female, Range: A3-E5)

Performances of the show are weekends between October 9 and 30. Rehearsals will be scheduled flexibly in August and September. Early rehearsals for the youth roles will be scheduled to accommodate their unique schedules. The roles come with a small stipend between \$100-\$200 based on attendance.
